

MUST READ INSTRUCTOR INSTRUCTIONS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PEOPLE WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

- Connect to the internet for access to videos in the PowerPoint
- Launch PowerPoint
- Test the videos embedded in the PowerPoint
 - If the embedded videos do not work, open the videos on YouTube (see attached list) and minimize on screen until needed
- Distribute copies of PowerPoint
- **Anticipatory:**
 - **Discuss class's familiarity with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities**
 - **Experience in interactions with individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities—media accounts they may have heard of**
- Introduce any guests who will be co-presenting and/or participating in the scenarios

- For Section 6 “Law Enforcement Scenarios”
 - **If self-advocates are present to participate in the role play**
 - Identify two police officers for each of the three scenarios
 - Ask the two police officers to leave the room prior to their assigned scenario beginning
 - Review the “Police Objectives” – what the officers should observe in the scenario
 - Invite the two police officers back into the room
 - Begin the scenario
 - Debrief by asking the “Questions for Police Officers” and “Questions for Self-Advocates”
 - Repeat all of the above for each scenario
 - **If self-advocates are not present**
 - Review the “Police Objectives”
 - Read the scenario
 - Ask the “Questions for Police Officers”
 - Repeat the above for each scenario
- Distribute “Entry Level Assessment: Intellectual and/or Developmental Disabilities”
